

# tkIS India donates Digital Educational Accessories to Shishu Vihar Mandal in Dadar

tkIS India continued its CSR initiatives for 2017-18, with projects for the education sector. In the first of four consecutive projects in the month of July 2018, tkIS India donated Digital Educational Accessories to the Shishu Vihaar Mandal, Dadar, Mumbai, a School for the underprivileged children in the area. The donations included e-learning kits, comprising a projector, laptop, screen and speakers for six class rooms of the School.

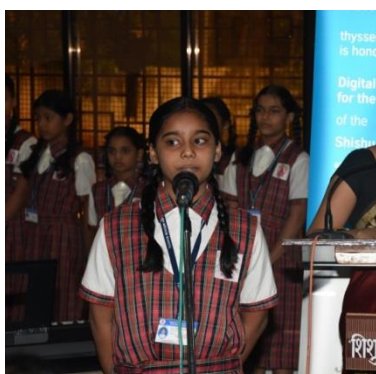
Shishu Vihaar Mandal was founded by Padmabhushan Smt Tarabai Modak, the first Visionary who had started Balshikshan (now widely known as Kindergarten) in 1936. The inauguration ceremony started with garlanding of the statue of Smt Tarabai Modak and lamp lighting by the dignitaries, before moving on to the inauguration of the Digital Classrooms.
