Mr V Madhavan, Vice President – Project Execution was part of the panel adjudicating the **Project Management Institute – India Awards 2019**, held recently. The Jury panel comprising thought leaders & industry experts was tasked with shortlisting the winning nominations, in the final stage of the award process. The adjudicating panel reviewed nominations from pan-India across multiple industries, in closed-door meetings in early August 2019. Mr. Madhavan being a Program Management professional (PgMP®) practicing in the Process Plant EPC Industry, was invited to be a Jury Member by PMI.

The categories included :

- Best Project of the Year
 - Large-sized Project (budgets in excess of Rs 1,000 cr)
 - Medium-sized Project (budget between Rs 100 to Rs 1,000 cr)
 - Small-sized Project (budget from Rs 5 cr to Rs 100 cr)
 - Micro-sized Project (budget between Rs 50 lakhs and Rs 5 cr)
- Project of the Year – Contribution to the Community

Instituted in 2009, the PMI India Awards recognize and honor a project team that has delivered superior results through exemplary application of project management principles. The recipients of the PMI awards exhibit achievements and talents of their respective company and project teams that exemplify project management excellence. The award recognizes the efforts of project teams, for successfully completing the project in the agreed time frame, the complexity of the project and marked budget and also for realizing the benefits that were intended at the start of the project.

The awards were given away at a glittering award ceremony in Hyderabad on 20th Sep 2019, during the PMI National Conference for the year.

PMI is also celebrating the 50 years of global presence of the institute this year.
